 On this the eighteenth day of April 1832
 personally appeared before me William
 Snow acting justice of the peace for the County
 & County of said James Rawlins who being
 first duly sworn according to Law deposed &
 said that he is the identical James Rawlins
 who was a private in the Company of Captain
 Bizer who commanded a recruiting Company
 of volunteers in the State of Indiana in the
 years 1814 & 1815 that he enlisted in the
 Service of the United States by enrolling
 himself in said Company about the last
 days of April (1814) or the first day in May
 of the same year - that he has never since
 seen or heard of said Company or what was then termed
 Clark's Grant that he enlisted for the term of
 one year (12 mo) and served out his time faithfully
 & was honorably discharged at Vincennes Indi-
 ana about the last days of Apr (1815) or the first
 day in May of same year - and that he has lost
 his discharge card that he has also forgotten his
 full name and that he has never received from
 the Government of the United States any Land for
 Services rendered him & he makes this declarati-
 on of his own free will & under oath in the best of
 his knowledge from this fact & refers to the depositions for proof
 in the musters of said Company of
 Snow test & subscribed before
 me this above day & date James Rawlins
 William Snow J.P.
